## Day 1



### Induction

- Meet your fellow students and start to work as a team
- Learn about the Simulation Centre

### Skills Centre Training

- Learn and practice essential monitoring
- Help the team 'save a life'. Work out what happened and debrief (review of events)
- Meet your patients and record their medical history
- Suture (stitch) up a wound
- Learn and practice life-saving skills CPR (Cardiac Pulmonary Resuscitation)
- Learn how to use an ultrasound machine

## Day 2



### Introduction

- Put your skills learnt on day 1 into practice

### Simulated patient journeys (scenarios)

- Help the team to care for your first patient
- Work as a team in smaller groups to help more patients
- Learn to *scrub* for an operation & take a *selfie*
- Perform virtual keyhole surgery for prizes
- Check your life-saving skills
- Question the doctors and medical students

## Payment Details

STH will invoice the school/college directly for the full amount due for their students\*. You will need to provide a Purchase Order Number from your finance department when your student/s have been offered a place on the programme. Invoice will be sent to your organisation following the event.

### Terms & Conditions
